## UNIFORMED DRESS CODE



Please make provisions for students to be in uniforms the entire school year. Parents may choose from the following **Monday – Friday options below.**

**BOTTOMS:** Khaki, Black, and navy blue pants, shorts, capris, or skorts.



**TOPS:** Black, Gray, Maroon/Burgundy, and White polo or collared shirt.



### **SHOES:**

- All shoes must be safe and appropriate, low heeled or flat.
- Athletic shoes are required for PE classes.
- Slippers, flip flops, and slides are not permitted. Sandals with a back strap are permitted.

### **NOTE:**

- No jeggings/leggings
- No midriff revealing or see-through clothing
- No spandex or tight-fitting attire
- No sagging or ripped pants
- Shorts/Skorts/skirts must be knee length
- No bandanas, hats or hoodies inside the building

### **REMINDERS:**

- The dress and appearance of the student should be neat, clean and proper as it is a reflection of both home and school.
- The uniform is a symbol of pride, unity, and excellence at Bethune Middle School.
- The local school Administration team reserves the right to make the final judgement on matters relating to the appropriateness of any item of dress, make-up, hair, jewelry, or any matter relating to student appearance.
